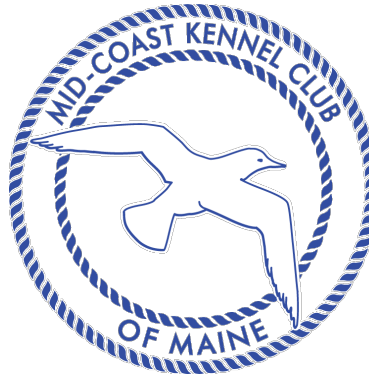

Routes to the Show

From the SOUTH:

295 North to Route 1N travel approximately 42 miles to intersection of Rte 90. Stay on Rte 1 past the Rte 90 intersection and Midcoast Athletics Center is 0.3 miles on the left. Turn left just past Maritime Farms convenience store, to access the MAC parking lot. Proceed to the left side of the building and through the open gate in the chain link fence for trial parking. Entry door to the gymnasium is the door closest to the rear of the building.

From the NORTH:

Take US RTE1 South to Camden. Take a right onto Rte. 90. Travel 10.8 miles to Rte 1 intersection. Turn left onto Route 1 N [(Atlantic Highway) and Midcoast Athletics Center is 0.3 miles on the left. Turn left just past Maritime Farms convenience store to access the MAC parking lot. Proceed to the left side of the building and through the open gate in the chain link fence for trial parking. Entry door to the gymnasium is the door closest to the rear of the building.

Entering the Facility

Service dogs and handlers needing wheelchair access will be allowed in the lobby and should use designated parking spots near the main entrance.

General Entry

Enter through the rear door near exhibitor parking area and to the left of the building. Only service dogs and handlers needing wheelchair access will be allowed in the main entrance and lobby.

Note: NO OVERNIGHT PARKING WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS.

General Information

- The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident, illness or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this Trial.
- The club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the AKC entry forms for this event.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

Final Confirmation

- Check in and Armband pick up procedures will be communicated at time of final confirmation.

Class Start Times

- A lunch break will be taken between trials on both Saturday and Sunday.

Crating / Facility Information

- There will be limited inside crating. The parking area is private and safe for crating in your vehicle. PLEASE, if you have a dog who cannot be quiet in your vehicle, do not park up against the building. Please clean up after your dogs and keep the site clean. Exercise your dogs only on trial premises.
- **NO FLEXI LEADS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING.**
- NO SMOKING or alcoholic beverages allowed on the grounds.
- *Elev8 Energy and Nutrition* is on site in the lobby. Additionally, there are 2 convenience stores very close by where other offerings will be available.

COVID Protocol and Procedures

If you are entering Rally and Obedience on the same day, the entry fee is \$32 for first entry of dog in Rally and \$32 for first entry of dog in Obedience. If you are entering multiple classes in Rally or Obedience on that same day, the ADDITIONAL entry fee then applies. Please note that all final confirmations, armband numbers and judging programs
will be sent by email unless otherwise requested by the exhibitor.



- All entries must be signed by the owner or authorized agent. Errors on entry forms are the responsibility of the owner. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management and it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry will be made.
- Entry fees will not be refunded for dogs that are absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition.
- Entry fees for bitches who come in season after the close of entries but before the start of the trial will be refunded the entry fee less a \$5 admin fee. No later than 30 minutes before the start of the trial, the owner must provide to the TRIAL SECRETARY (1) a veterinary statement written on their vet's stationary and (2) their Final Confirmation. Refunds requested after the start of the trial will NOT be given for any reason.
- There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date (except for the exceptions above) or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.
- Transfers and Move Ups **WILL** be allowed at these trials.
- The trial will be open from 7:00 am to 5:00 pm. Dogs may arrive any time prior to scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. **There will be no access to the trial grounds for set up prior to the trial date.**
- Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the ring. Problems relating to conflicts in class schedules should be brought to the Stewards'/Judge's attention prior to the start of judging that class.
