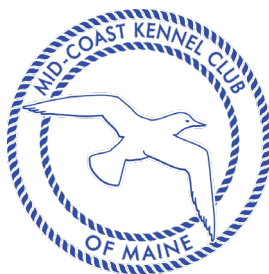

Take 295 North (toward Falmouth/Portland/US-1) to US-1 Exit (#28), 42 miles; to Left onto Rte 90, 10.8 miles; left onto US Rte 1 N, 2.1 mi; to left onto Rte 52/Mountain St., 6.1 miles to stop sign; Bear Right onto Rte 173/ Beach Road, go 0.5 miles on Beach Road to Calderwood Lane on the right; **Spot On Dog Training Center** is 0.2 miles up on the right.

From the NORTH:

Take US RTE1 South to Belfast. Right onto Rte 52/Lincolnvile Ave. 10.8 miles to Left onto Rte 173/Me 52/Main Street proceed 0.8 miles. Left onto Beach Rd., 0.5 miles to Calderwood Lane, 0.2 miles to **Spot On Dog Training Center** on the right.

- All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

Crating / Facility Information

- No inside crating will be available. PLEASE, if you have a dog who cannot be quiet in your vehicle, do not park up against the building

Telephone and unsigned entries **CANNOT** be accepted. Entries not on an Official AKC Entry Form and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**.

Entry Limits: Obedience, 3.5 hours of judging each trial; Rally, 35 entries each trial. A waitlist will be maintained until closing date.

Entries close **October 21, 2026 at 6PM**, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, or substituted.

Please note that all final confirmations, armband numbers and judging programs will be sent by email unless otherwise requested by the exhibitor.

- All entries must be signed by the owner or authorized agent. Errors on entry forms are the responsibility of the owner. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management and it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry will be made.
- Entry fees will not be refunded for dogs that are absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition.
- Entry fees for bitches who come in season after the close of entries but before the start of the trial will be refunded the entry fee less a \$5 admin fee. No later than 30 minutes before the start of the trial, the owner must provide (1) a veterinary statement written on their vet's stationary and (2) their Final Confirmation. Refunds requested after the start of the trial will NOT be given

for any reason.

- There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date (except for the exceptions above) or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.
- Transfers and Move Ups **WILL** be allowed at these trials.
- The trial will be open from 7:30 am to 5:00 pm. Dogs may arrive any time prior to scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. **There will be no access to the trial grounds for set-up prior to the trial date.**
- Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the ring. Problems relating to conflicts in class schedules should be brought to the Stewards'/Judge's attention prior to the start of judging that class.
